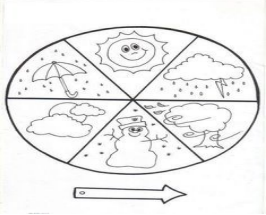


Eyfs – Activities Grid

What is the weather like today? Make a weather clock. Each day move the hand of the clock to show the correct weather. 	Go on a nature rainbow scavenger hunt around your garden. What can you find to make a nature rainbow? Stick what you find in the correct order to make a rainbow collage, Remember: red orange yellow green blue indigo violet	Did you see any butterflies on you nature hunt? Count every time you see one. Make a toilet roll holder butterfly. Remember to Make the wings Symmetrical. 	Did you see any flowers in your garden during your nature hunt? Make a hand print picture of flowers. 	Make a kite for the windy days on your weather clock. Make the kite a diamond shape. Decorate. Add string and some bows. Have fun flying your kite. Take photos to show your friends later.
Design a super hero for yourself. What would your name be? What would your super power be? Draw a picture of you as a superhero 	Does your superhero wear cuffs, a cape or a mask? What colours do you wear? Make the things you need to dress as your superhero. Take a picture of you dressed as a superhero. Send/email the picture to your teacher at school.	Make a help jar/pot. Write 10 different ways your superhero can help their family on 10 strips of paper. Pop them in the jar. Each day pull one out and do that job to help your family.	Think of a story about your superhero. Tell your story using pictures like a comic strip. 	Write a letter to your teacher. Tell her about your superhero. What is your name? what do you wear? What is your super power? Use the letters and sounds to help you spell the words.

Remember to keep a list of the books you read.	Use “Teach your monster to read” and play reading games.  https://www.teachyourmonstertoread.com/ [free account] at least three times a week.	Practice writing some of the sounds you have practiced on “Teach your monster to read”. What words have you learnt? Draw pictures of the characters you have met.	How is your plant diary going? Have your seeds grown tall?  What do they need to grow? Remember to keep a regular diary of how your seeds grow with pictures as things change.
