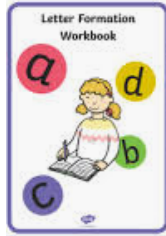
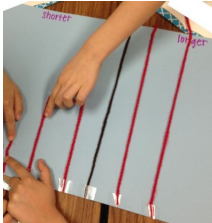
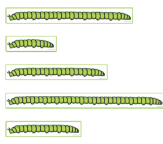


Daily Literacy and Maths Activities - wb - 4th May

Literacy This week we are going to start a new project that we will work on over the next few weeks—look out for the extra pages to help you with the activities.	Reading together! Listen to the story of Mavis the Magical Cat. https://soundcloud.com/talkforwriting/mavis Follow through the story reading it as you listen with a grown up, using the attached Day 1 pages. Use the points and pictures at the bottom of the last page to help you talk about the story together.	Vocabulary work! Look at the Day 2 ladybird words page with an adult. Say each word and talk about what they mean! Choose one of the pictures to match with what each word means. Draw your own picture for each word to show what it means.	Role play! Today we are going to pretend to be the characters in the story. Read through each paragraph one at a time, on the Day 3 page, with a grown up, and act out how you think the character would behave. What would their facial expressions be like? How would they stand or move?	Learning a rhyme! Read through the rhyme on the Day 4 page. How can you make this into an action rhyme? Learn the rhyme adding in your actions and practice saying it out loud confidently. 	Handwriting practice! Complete 2 pages in your letter formation booklet. Think carefully where the letter starts and which way it goes! Always start from the dot! 
Maths This week we are going to look at measuring length and height!	Draw around your hand and cut it out. Look around the house and outside space and draw things that are smaller than your hand, bigger than your hand and things that are about the same size.  Now do the same with your foot. Which things are the same?	Using any type of construction such as duplo, sticklebricks, blocks, knex etc. build a tower as tall as you. How many did you use? Build a tower for someone else in your house, how many more or less did you use? 	Ask a grown up to cut some pieces of string, ribbon or wool etc. in lots of different sizes. Order the pieces from shortest to longest. Stick some of them in your workbook. 	Use the Day 4 maths activity sheet and cut out the caterpillars and place them in order on the leaves. [Draw them yourself if you are unable to print] Count how many leaves long each caterpillar is. 	Complete 2 pages in your number formation booklet.  Think carefully where the number starts and which way it goes! Always start from the dot!
