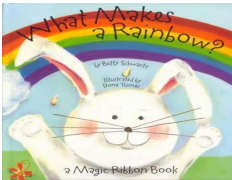
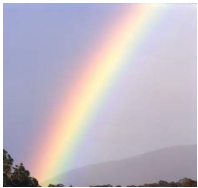
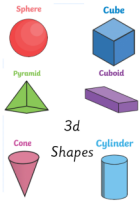


Daily Literacy and Maths Activities

Literacy	Read/Watch and learn the story of the 'What makes a Rainbow' story https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=U2aypaRsCjI Learn the correct colours of the rainbow in the right order. Can you learn a rainbow song to help you.. Red, Orange, Yellow, Green, Blue, Indigo, Violet.	Make a rainbow picture or collage. Remember to put the colours in the correct order. Write the name of each colour next to it in the rainbow. Can you write a list of other things that are that colour?	What conditions do we need to make a rainbow? Write two or more sentences to explain how a rainbow is made. 	Go on a colour walk around your house. Write down all the things you find which are the same colour as the colours in the rainbow. 	Complete 2 pages in your letter formation booklet. Think carefully where the letter starts and which way it goes! Always start from the dot! 
Maths 	Look at the 3d shapes sheet on the website. Have a look around your home and see what you can find that are these shapes. Draw all the things you find and label them.	Listen to and learn the Jack Hartman song about 3d shapes. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=zPZegz690Mg - Sing the song with an adult at home to learn about the shapes.	All 3d shapes have faces. The faces are often 2d shapes that we know. Look at the 3d shapes and see which ones have circles, squares, rectangles and triangles as faces!	Choose one of the 3d shapes and make a poster telling us all about it. Describe it carefully and draw a picture of it. Draw the thing you found that are this shape.	Complete 2 pages in your number formation booklet.  Think carefully where the number starts and which way it goes! Always start from the dot!
