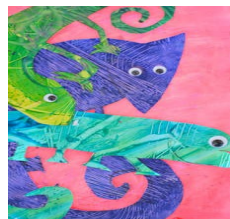


Daily Literacy and Maths Activities

Literacy

Read/Watch and learn the story of the 'The Mixed Up Chameleon' <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=FrmZeXf7ScU> Tell an adult the list of colours in the story. Which colour is your favourite? Draw a picture using this colour.

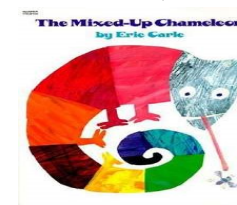
Choose 1 or more animals from the story. Write the sentence to accompany it. EG 'The frog is green.'



Choose an animal that is not in the story. Then write the sentence that the Chameleon would say. 'I wish I could be....like a....'

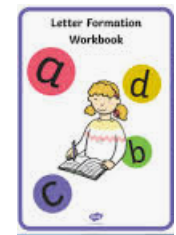


Draw your own mixed up animal (like the chameleon) draw different parts of animals to make a new mixed up one. Label each part to show which animal it comes from.



Complete 2 pages in your letter formation booklet.

Think carefully where the letter starts and which way it goes! Always start from the dot!



Maths

Write a number to 10/20 then add 1. Write as a number sentence.

Eg. $8+1=9$.

Then repeat for all the numbers to 10/20. Don't forget 0!

Remember how to write the numbers correctly. Check in your number formation booklet.

Write a number to 10/20. Then take away 1. Write as a number sentence. Eg. $7-1=6$

Then repeat for all the numbers to 10/20.

Remember how to write the numbers correctly. Check in your number formation booklet.

Draw a large square. Then divide it into 4 smaller squares. Sort out coins into 4 piles. (1p's in one square, 2p's in another etc).

Draw around the coins and write the number inside. Learn to recognise the different coins by their shape, colour and size and the number inside the coin.

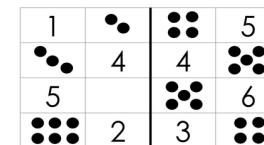


Make a set of number dominoes.

Write numbers to 10/20 on a side of the cards. Then draw corresponding numbers of objects on the other side of the cards.

Count the objects carefully.

Once complete, play the game with an adult. Match the number to the correct set of objects.
