Make a Viking artefact (jewellery, sword, spear or shield) using materials found at home.

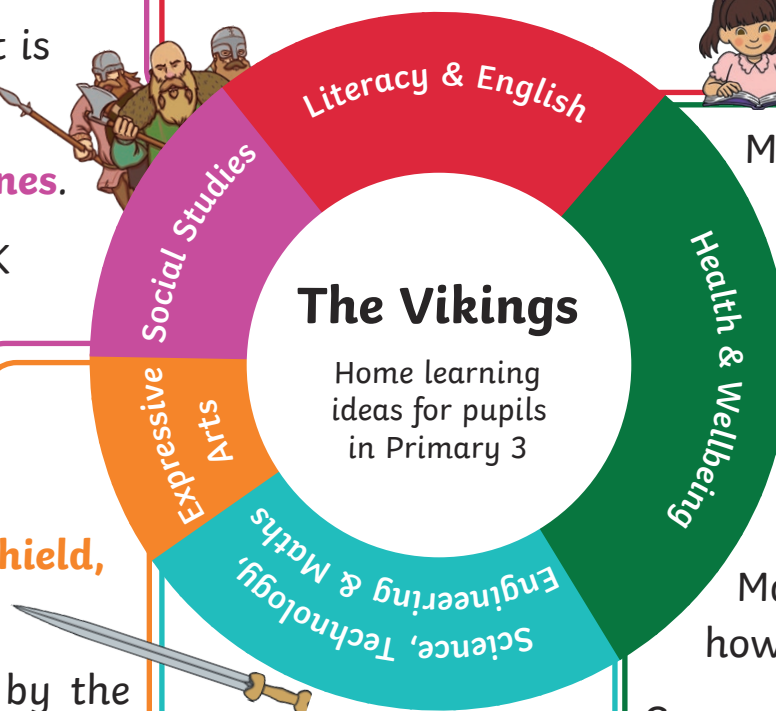
